## HKA Awards 2022: The best among the best got awarded



This year, the HKA Awards were finally presented live again on site to the best graduates of the Karlsruhe University of Applied Sciences. Anneke Reinsperger led through the event in an entertaining way, presented outstanding degree theses in short films and encouraged the guests to participate in the HKA quiz.

Franziska Kempf received the prize of the Technologiepark Karlsruhe GmbH for her brilliant master's degree in mechanical engineering. In her thesis "Development of an active stabilization of a mobile manipulator" Ms. Kempf proved that she has an extraordinary talent for

scientific work. The algorithm developed for stabilizing articulated-arm robots on mobile platforms not only required an in-depth examination of the underlying theory, but also proved that it has great skill in practical implementation on the test subject. In addition, her written and oral presentation of the results were far above average. The results of the work are currently being prepared for publication in a scientific journal.

## COMPETENCE AND INNOVATION

The structural work of our new TPK building are gradually coming to an end. We took this progress as an opportunity and celebrated the roofing ceremony on October 13th. The celebration took place in a correspondingly informal and rustic setting and served as a thank you for the people involved in the construction. In the foreseeable future our new building 9C will finally offer tailor-made space solutions for all future tenants. By the end of 2023, around 11,500 m<sup>2</sup> of gross floor space will be created on five floors. The walls can be placed flexibly, and the division of the area follows the wishes of the tenants. Except for individual pillars and walls, all elements can be moved. And, of course, there are opportunities for growth. **Because the future needs space.**
