The official opening of the facility will take place on Friday, the 9th of July 2021 at 03:30 pm.

But what actually is calisthenics? Calisthenics, nowadays also commonly known as "street workout", is becoming more and more popular. Training with your own body weight in public spaces is a trend sport with sustainability. In principle, it is like a big playground for young people, adults and seniors with fitness potential. The sport focuses on work and strength with one's own body weight and enables a full-body workout without much technical effort.

The calisthenics facility will be built on an area of around 350m² in the middle of the Traugott Bender Sports Park. It is surrounded by trees and seating mounds and fits wonderfully into the sports landscape of the entire facility as a complementary building block. The facility is built on a solid foundation and equipped with a special fall protection floor. The equipment leaves nothing to be desired. Whether for a short workout in the lunch break or a longer session after work - the facility offers something for everyone and every time window. The calisthenics facility is sure to become a highlight of the Traugott Bender Sports Park. It is easily accessible, can be used by everyone, is animating and thus offers a great sporting, health and also social added value for the surrounding companies and districts.
