10th Foosball Championship



For the anniversary of the TPK Foosball Championship, 25 teams from eight different companies from the TPK competed against each other. The tournament was sponsored by Valantic, Telemaxx, andrena objects and TPK, who together donated 2,000 euros to Reha-Südwest. The donation will be used for interdisciplinary early support for children with developmental risks and delays, as well as impending or existing disabilities.

The tournament started with the explanation of the rules and the draw for the first of six rounds in the Swiss system. Here all teams play in groups, with the pairings being determined based on the teams' placement. 16 of 25 teams reached the knockout round.

“Peter und der Wolf” by andrena were again in the final and competed against the surprise team “Bumm Bumm Yoga Hektiker”, also by andrena. “Peter und der Wolf” were a little more aggressive than their opponents and won in two sets with 6:5 and 6:4. This meant they secured their 3rd title in a row! In the game for third place, the “Schmetterlinge” from Exxeta defeated andrena’s “Rückpass” with 7:6.
